The Rock Capital IP Top 20 Global Fund is a moderate to high risk flexible fund. The objective of this portfolio is to achieve capital appreciation over the medium to long term.

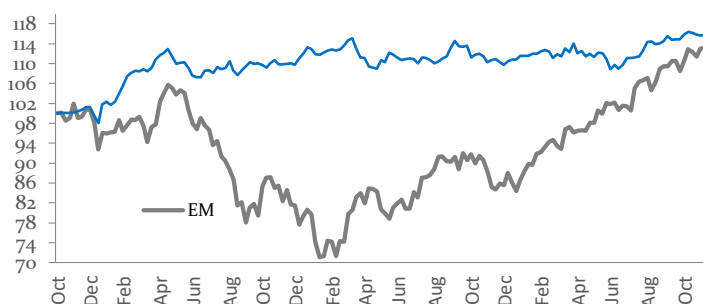

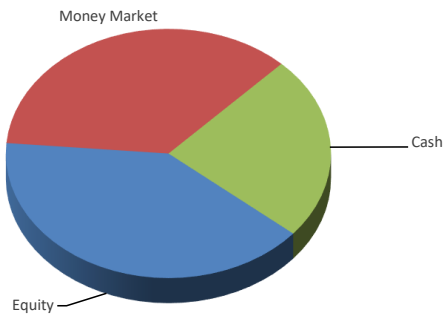

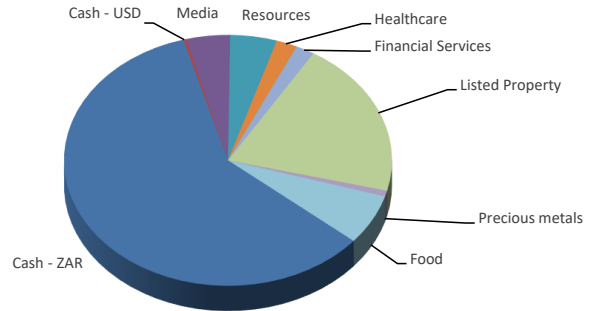

## Fund Commentary *(updated quarterly)*

Currently the markets are tentatively awaiting the results of the December ANC conference. At the moment the two front-runners are Cyril Ramaphosa and Nkosazana Dlamini-Zuma. Ramaphosa is running on an anti-corruption ticket and his chances of winning seem to increase with every new Gupta related scandal, whereas Dlamini-Zuma is repeating Jacob Zuma's 'radical economic transformation' rhetoric. A Ramaphosa victory will be viewed as a much more positive outcome for the markets.
